5 Ways We Can Help Save Sea Turtles:

1. Turn Out Lights Visible from Beaches: artificial light confuses hatchlings as they find their way to the water

2. Clean Up Trash on Beaches:

Turtles can become tangled in plastic, and they will eat trash, which can lead to injury or death

3. Avoid Nesting Areas:

Light and people disturb hatchlings as they are nesting

4. Reduce the Amount of Chemicals You Use:

Chemicals you use on your lawn and in your home wash into coastal waters, killing plants and animals

5. Volunteer

Loggerheads are endangered because:

- Hunted for eggs and leather
- Tangled and drown in fishing gear and shrimp nets
- Pollution and debris
- Collisions with boats and propellers
- 200,000 estimated left









Ways We Can Help:

- National Marine Fisheries Service and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service are working through ESA (Endangered Species Act) to protect sea turtles
- Keep beaches clean and avoid walking on nests
- WWF works with fisheries to switch to "turtle friendly" hooks and nets
