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Expectations:

Teachers will record the following information daily. The information will travel with the students throughout their school day across multiple settings.

IA= Inappropriate Language

V= Verbal Aggression/Arguing

PA= Physical Aggression

LC= Lying/Cheating

R= Refusal to Work

FD= Not Following Directions

H/T= Harassment/Teasing

B= Disruption/Blurting

D= Defiance/Disrespect/Non-Compliance

PM= Property Misuse

MI= Major Infractions

Infractions are recorded daily and sent home with students for parents to sign each night.

6th Infraction within a day = Detention after School

7th Infraction within a day = In-School Suspension (Principal's Office/Partner Classroom)

Major Infraction = Office Referral/Principal calls home

The Brookings Elementary School staff has set reasonable expectations for all students in the school in order to teach students to accept responsibility and consequences for their actions and to recognize students for positive actions and behaviors. Students who display inappropriate behaviors will receive an Infraction. Students receiving six Infractions within a single day may serve after-school detention from 3:30-4:00. Students receiving seven Infractions within a week will serve in-school suspension in the Principal's Office or Partner Classroom. Major Infractions such as destruction of property or fighting may face in-school suspension and a parent conference may be held. Brookings Elementary Schools will not tolerate bullying or any violent behaviors. Students with zero infractions at the end of the week will be eligible for a weekly reward. Students with zero infractions at the end of the quarter will be eligible for a quarterly reward. Student Incident Reports will be filled out for 6 infractions in one day or for any major infractions.
