Our tour isn't just with the helicopter; it starts with a helicopter tour. The helicopter will fly from Rio de Janeiro airport, taking the lovely tourists over the Amazon Rainforest. The pilot will talk a little bit about the rainforest, be sure to get your cameras ready, it will be a memory of a life time. After the tour, the helicopter will land at the ranger's station, then you'll take an hour boat ride, and during that journey you will see lots of diverse plants and animals accompanied by one of a kind tour educator. If you're lucky, you may even see a very colorful scarlet macaw parrot or various cute monkeys. Watch out for piranhas. Also a good item to take is the bug spray; there are a lot of biting insects here like the mosquito. The Amazon Rainforest has the most diverse plant and animal species of this world, so you'll never get this experience anywhere else! Also we do our best to teach about environmental protection. We feel it's very bad that the Amazon Rainforest is slowly lost due to deforestation that's why we do everything we can to educate and protect it.
